Location Farm Hill House Hill Lane Old Alresford Alresford Hampshire SO24 9RJ

Proposal This application is for the development of a stable building (along with

storage for land management) to serve the land at Farm Hill House, Old Alresford, Alresford, Hampshire, SO24 9RJ. The building will serve the land of around 38 acres and will provide 2 stables as well as storage space for tack, feed and hay to support a private equestrian use. It will also contain further storage space for machinery and equipment for agricultural and land management purposes on the

applicant's land.
